OLD BUSINESS

Landscape committee update reported by Eric Brannen: ATLANTA

LANDSCAPE- GROUP- Irrigation replacement in Section A at the Beech Haven entrance, Ivy Gate Circle and townhomes on Ivy Ridge Dr. side of the community has been completed by ATANTA LANDSCAPING COMPANY. The contact with ATLANTA LANDSCAPING COMPANY has been cancelled effective January 31, 2019. Irrigation replacement in Section EF (Condos and English Ivy Circle) is the next section to be completed in 2019 by the new landscape company. Areas have been marked for utilities, electric, gas and cable. Eric Brannen is following up on keeping the anticipated time frame. During the process plans are being made for replacement plants/shrubbery for planting in 2019. The Manor is the remaining area where the irrigation system will be completed 2019.

SAFTEY PROPOSAL FOR OLDE IVY has been approved and we are waiting on bids f to be presented to the NBOD BOARD is pending. John Holthaus to follow up on this project as the head of the Infrastructure Committee.

BEECH HAVEN DAMAGED BRICK PAVERS- Brick pavers were damaged at the entrance of Beech Haven Gate due to a truck backing in to area near callbox from the construction site across the street. NBOD has received proposals from CASTLE CONTRACTING AND BGC for the brick repair. Karen Gantt and Rod Johnson to meet with Brandon Parker, MTC CORPORATION Project Manager to discuss the resolve of the repair.

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
NEW BUSINESS-

-Drainage Project on English Ivy Court has been approved and work will start

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——State Farm Insurance claim has been submitted for the replacement of the 120 townhomes in Olde Ivy and the clubhouse. When the work begins the clubhouse will need to be completed prior to the opening of the pool May 1, 2019. BCG and AMERISTAR are bidding on the project for the roof replacements and will get back to the board by the first of February 2019.
——Olde Ivy Clubhouse lease agreement amendments to be reviewed by attorney Olde Ivy Marvin Pastel. There was on clubhouse lease agreement denial due to the fact that the resident was not in good standing with the community.
—-Meter Transmission Units(MTU) replacements over seen by John Bennison in the Olde Ivy neighborhood has completed 2 phases replacing 36 out of 34 units in the Manors and 1 at the Goddard School.
——Asphalt repairs project to be explored by John Holthaus for repairs, selling and stripping. He will look into getting estimates and plans for execution.
——Kelvin Garmon of Ray Engineering to survey the drainage problem in the backyard areas of the residents on the left side of the street on English Ivy Court.
